The SEISMOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF AMERICA is devoted to the advancement of earthquake science. As a member of SSA, you keep up to date with research in seismology and related fields through the Society's publications and conferences.

As a member of SSA, you help define the concerns and research interests of the seismological community. You support the Society's efforts to communicate the results of earth science research to those in government and industry who make decisions regarding seismic risk.

You join other members, located throughout the world, representing a variety of technical interests: seismologists and other geophysicists, geologists, engineers, insurers, and policymakers in preparedness and safety.

Dues for regular members start at \$100 for all electronic journals (no print). For an additional \$10-\$50, members can get either *SRL* or both *SRL* and *BSSA* in print. Print *BSSA* is \$10 higher for members outside North America (a reflection of higher mailing costs). Dues for students are \$25-\$35. Students must submit a photocopy of their current validated student ID to qualify for the student discount. Members not living in high-income economies as determined by the World Bank are eligible for the discounted member rate of \$45.

Both regular and student members have access to the full-text electronic editions of *BSSA* and *Seismological Research Letters* as part of their membership. Those who pay extra may also receive these journals in print form. Dues include media/economy rate shipping. Priority delivery of the print journals is available for an extra charge.

Institutional subscriptions to *BSSA* and *SRL* are also available. You may contact the Society Headquarters for further information.

BSSA is the premier journal of advanced research in earthquake seismology and related disciplines. It first appeared in 1911. Each issue is composed of scientific papers on the various aspects of seismology, including investigation of specific earthquakes, theoretical and observational studies of seismic waves, inverse methods for determining the structure of the Earth or the dynamics of the earthquake source, seismometry, earthquake hazard and risk estimation, seismotectonics, and earthquake engineering. Special issues focus on important earthquakes or rapidly changing topics in seismology.

Subscriptions to *BSSA*: The 2010 subscription rate for institutions and other nonmembers in North America is \$565 (\$575 outside North America) and includes both the print and the electronic editions.
